mLearn brings learning to your mobile display Mobile people want to learn mobile

Each day people pass a lot of time on the move – on the train or not infrequently in a traffic jam. Why not spend this time reasonably, for example on learning? The "TestCenter" made by mLearn brings the learning to your mobile display. Knowledge acquired at home can be tested and increased any time anywhere. With regard to e-learning KMU Net sets priorities.

The "TestCenter" is one of the modules of the e-learning solution based on the Internet which has been worked out by KMU Net.

The organisers of the appropriate educational establishments will be able to create their own tests by means of a simple and intuitive system – a special training is not required.

Via the mobile learners can download a test any time anywhere and thus repeat their knowledge.

It can be very easily dealt with: Downloading a test to or entering the answers into the mobile, is done in the same manner as keying in a short message.

I mmediately after sending the answers, the result of the test will appear on the mobile display and, in addition, be transmitted to the learner's private mail-box. The mobile is connected to the e-learning platform so that the result can be directly integrated and evaluated.

When practising next time – home or place of work – learners can refer to these results and, if desired, ask for advanced learning tasks.

With its progressing development mLearn/KMU makes learning even more effective: I ndependent of stationary hardware or access to the I nternet learners can test and increase their knowledge, and thus be able to advance in knowledge. This ensures an effective learning process.

A specimen test developed by mLearn/KMU Net is integrated into the online environment.

In co-operation with the Adult Education System in Lower Saxony it was agreed upon to start operating the "TestCenter".

Another co-operation was made with the German Asia Pacific Company e. V. (incorporated society) in Cologne. A test specially designed for this organisation should provide the staff with knowledge regarding social manners in intercultural teams.

Further operational fields are being evaluated. mLearn/KMU trusts that the greatest potential lies in vocational education. Ever growing product cycles compel the business management to provide their staff with flexible and up-to-date training. The "TestCenter" helps to test and assess existing knowledge. As a result the necessity to provide quality improvements and extra training becomes obvious and the need for training can be better planned.

Facts and data

For the last 8 years KMU Net has been managing collaborative learning systems based on the software "FirstClass".

Clemens Wudel (41, business economist, time-and-methods specialist) is the business manager and has been engaged in the fields of online learning, development of company organisation and knowledge for many years.

At the beginning of this year mLearn has been established as subsidiary of KMU Net in order to progress e-learning. Here all the developments and e-learning projects will be integrated.
